The Photo ID Card module manages four critical functions, which together give you complete control over access to your facilities.

Digital Camera Subsystem

The MEMBERS ONLY Photo-ID system begins with any Twain-compatible digital camera. We have had great results with cameras from Kodak, and are currently recommending the Kodak DVC 325. These sleek light-weight units can be attached to the top of a PC, and used to take pictures of your members. Rather than fuss with manual controls on the camera, the unit is controlled directly from MEMBERS ONLY, and the picture is stored in the database, to be retrieved to the screen at any time.

Photo ID Card Printing

The Fargo Persona C10 Color-Card printer prints your identification on durable plastic cards, capable of lasting for years. We've test laundered the cards with great results. The card shows a picture, the member's name and card issue date, as well as a barcode. It takes approximately 60 seconds to issue a card. Cards can be reissued without taking another photograph, since the picture is stored in the database.

Card Scanning Subsystem

The members of your program simply scan their cards as they walk into the facility. The American Microsystems 2000 scanner is connected into a workstation on your network. The station immediately checks the standing of the member and reports back, with both a message to the monitor and a distinctive positive or negative sound. Members can be denied access if their membership has expired or been terminated, or if a user has set an alert on their record. The text of the alert will appear on the screen in such an event.

Access Statistics

Each time a card is scanned, the system records the date, time, and location of the scan. The system also records whether the card was accepted or rejected, and the reason for all rejections. Reports and graphs are available from the system showing usage of all your key facilities, by date, by time, and by age and sex of the member.
